

Average course load -	ESIGELEC uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS): the usual workload for an ESIGELEC student is 30 ECTS credits per semester. Exchange students can choose between 20 ECTS credits min. to 30 ECTS credits max. per semester.
Tuition fees -	Exchange students are exempted from fees at ESIGELEC, however, they will have to pay tuition fees in their home university.
Language electives -	French, English, German, Spanish

Tips for course selection

Exchange students can:

• Choose courses from a single programme. That is, the same year not different years simultaneously.

• Select courses from a single semester, for example, from semester S2 only, not from semesters S2 and S4 simultaneously.

• Check the course prerequisites for a successful study at ESIGELEC.

Accommodation

ESIGELEC offers students assistance in reserving their accommodation in student hostels for the duration of their studies (based on availability). ESIGELEC does not have its own student hostels, however, ESIGELEC has partnerships with several student accommodation facilities (private and public) to offer students a number of housing options.

- Students who have been accepted to ESIGELEC can opt for ESIGELEC's accommodation assistance. Students may also choose to look for accommodation on their own.
- Average rent: 450 euros/month

• **Approximate cost of living:** An average of 800 euros/ month (including rent, tranportation, food, etc.)









Insurance

• Health insurance: compulsory for all students.

-EU students must hold the European Health Insurance Card.

-Non EU-students:

- Must have a private medical insurance upon arrival in France, valid for at least the 3 first months in France.
- Once in France, must apply for the French mandatory medical insurance (which is free of charge) more information on the <u>French health insurance</u> <u>website</u>.
- Accommodation insurance (compulsory for all students): approximately 35euros/ year for a single room
- **Civil liability**: All students must possess a civil liability insurance that covers them in France for the entire duration of their studies.
- **Repatriation insurance**: Likewise, it is imperative to subscribe to a repatriation insurance that covers the student for the entire duration of their stay in France.

"Bienvenue en France"

Pre-arrival webinair -	Organized prior to the arrival of students in France to help them adapt seamlessly to student life in France.
Airport pick up -	A shuttle service is arranged to pick up students from the Airport in Paris to their hostel in Rouen. Flight itinerary must be communicated to the International Relations Department ahead of time.
Welcome Days -	Upon arrival at ESIGELEC: Orientation sessions on student life in Rouen, digital tools, etc.
READY-SET-GO Forum -	Partner stands to assist with administrative processes eg. Opening of a French bank account, health insurance, french mobile phone plan, application for housing allowance, etc.

Inclusion and Accessibility

ESIGELEC's infrastructure is set up to the French standards for persons with reduced mobility. ESIGELEC doesn't have an in-house medical centre, our students have access to the preventive health care system of the University of Rouen, Normandy.

Visa and Resident Permit
