STUDENT SUPPORT

Immigration Students planning to study in Canada for one term (fewer than six months), may study under temporary resident status as a visitor. For any

period longer than six months (two terms), a study permit is required.

Students from some countries may be required to hold a temporary resident visa (entry visa) to enter Canada. The temporary resident visa (if required) will automatically be issued as part of a successful study permit

application.

Most students who do not require a visa require an electronic travel

authorization (eTA) to enter Canada.
