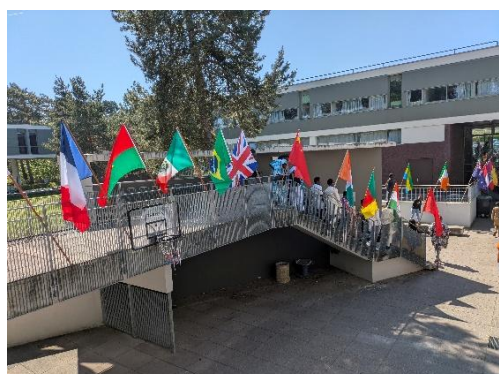

Upon nomination, the students will be able to apply online through our portal Esigelec ONESTOP : <https://eos.esigelec.fr/apply-en>

During the online application, students will have to upload the following documents:

- Proof of identity
- Curriculum vitae
- Transcript of records
- The ESIGELEC ONESTOP Learning agreement/Study plan for Erasmus+ students

**Application deadline:**

- September intake: 30th April
- February intake: 31st October

<b>Why choose ESIGELEC</b>	
<b>Pre-arrival webinars:</b>	Organized prior to the students' arrival in France to help them adapt seamlessly to student life in France
<b>Airport pick up:</b>	ESIGELEC will send a bus for a pick up at airport Paris Charles de Gaulle on a specific day before each intake, in order to drive the students to their accommodation in Rouen
<b>Welcome Days:</b>	Upon arrival at ESIGELEC, students will attend orientation sessions such as : student life in Rouen, digital tools, etc.
<b>READY-SET-GO Forum: (Only during September intake)</b>	Our different partners assist students with administrative processes such as opening a French bank account, applying for health insurance, obtaining a French mobile phone plan, applying for housing allowance, etc.
<b>Bienvenue en France label</b>	ESIGELEC holds "Bienvenue en France" label with a 2-star rating. This label is awarded to institutions wishing to highlight their welcome programmes

<b>Living in France</b>	
<b>Visa requirements:</b>	EU citizens: no visa is required. Non EU citizens: a visa is required, more information about visas is available on the French government website or at the nearest Campus France office, French consulate, or embassy.
<b>Accommodation:</b>	ESIGELEC does not have its own student residences. However, ESIGELEC holds a partnership with Studapart, a housing platform which offers a wide range of accommodation for students in the city of Rouen. <a href="https://esigelec.studapart.com/fr/">https://esigelec.studapart.com/fr/</a> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Average rent: 450 euros/month.</li> <li>➤ Approximate cost of living: 800 euros/month (including rent, transportation, food, etc.).</li> </ul>

<p><b>Health insurance:</b></p>	<p>EU students must hold the European Health Insurance Card          Non EU-students must have a private medical insurance upon arrival in France, valid for least the 3 first months in France. Once in France, they must apply for the French mandatory medical insurance (which is free of charge).</p>
<p><b>Other insurances:</b></p>	<p>Students must also have insurances covering the entire duration of their stay in France.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Civil liability insurance</li> <li>➤ Repatriation insurance</li> <li>➤ Accommodation insurance</li> </ul>
